Cooperativism in Paraná

Paraná's cooperativism follows through its development goals. In 2019, the 215 registered cooperatives in Ocepar System reached a revenue of US\$ 22,2 billion. In 2019, the first semester ended with 222 cooperatives registered and 8,3% growth in the revenue compared to previous years. Currently, the cooperativism is responsible for 113 thousand jobs and adds up to 2 million members. The cooperatives are the biggest employers in over 130 cities in Paraná. It has a strong regional performance, democratizes finance, offers high standard health services, organizes the economic activities and provides social and economic development of the towns in which they are present.



The Brazilian Organization of the Cooperatives classifies the cooperatives in seven sectors.

Sectors



There are 60 agricultural cooperatives of production in Paraná. In 2019, this sector registered a total revenue of US\$ 18,6 billion. Over 179 thousand farmers are associated to the agricultural cooperatives in Paraná, and 77 percent are considered small and medium farmers (areas up to 50 ha). Currently, almost 48% of the primary production of the members go through some transformation process and to aggregate value. Modern, but not losing their cooperativism essence, they export to over 100 countries. They invest in professional qualification, technical support to the members, and the diversification of the production. They help preventing the rural evasion, increasing the farmers income and promoting economy of the cities, where they are present.

S Credit

There are 56 credit cooperatives in Paraná. They provide financial services to the associates, for example: granting credit, taking of deposits, savings account, debit and credit cards, billing services and financial investments. They operate in four main systems: Sicredi Central PR/SP/RJ, Sicoob Central Unicoob, Uniprime Central e Cresol. There are also, credit cooperatives which are not linked to a central cooperative. The credit cooperatives in Paraná hold over US\$

We are the change. We are the future. We are a different business model. **Come with us!** 7,9 billion, they have over 2,1 million members, 1.312 customer service centers and more than 14,5 thousand employees. For the credit cooperative the associated person is the client and the business owner at the same time. It does not strive for profit; therefore, they practice more attractive taxes. They have a particular and personalized customer service, side by side to the member, working in regions where the traditional banks do not operate.

Work, and Production of Goods and Services

There are 10 cooperatives in Paraná classified in this sector, which was created in 2019 by the Brazilian Organization of the Cooperatives (OCB), as the result of the union of the following sectors: work, special, mineral and part of the tourism and leisure. It also gathers the educational cooperatives (teachers) and the labor production cooperatives, in which the production is collective.

Health

There are 37 health cooperatives in Paraná. They summon up to 15,7 thousand members and serve more than 2 million users annually. There are three health cooperative systems - Unimed, Dental Uni e Uniodonto. There are also cooperatives which are made up of health care professionals and do not need the health insurance registration at ANS, because they work directly with the core activity. As an example, there is the anesthetist's cooperative.

🔟 Infrastructure

There are 15 infrastructure cooperatives in Paraná. They operate in electricity generation and distribution. They also act in the construction of houses.

Transport

There are 39 transport cooperatives in Paraná. Gathering 4 thousand members, that own cargo and passenger carriers. The fleet has over 3,3 thousand heavy vehicles (medium and large sizes trucks).

Consumer

There are four consumer cooperatives in Paraná. They make joint purchase of goods and services for their members. This sector covers the trade of (market), as well as educational cooperatives made up of student's parents.
